## **Silent Auction Procedures**

The complete auction will be available for viewing and bidding at the Preview Party on Wednesday, December 9, 2009, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. and at Kama'aina Christmas on Saturday, December 12, 2009, from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

## **Bidding Process**

A bid sheet will be displayed with each item. Bids can be entered by legibly writing your name and telephone number and correct bid increment on the bid sheet. Please note and follow starting bids and minimum increments. You may bid on any item in the silent auction until the auction closes at **10:00 p.m.** on December 12, 2009. The highest valid bid at closing is the winning bid. If two or more bidders are bidding on the same item at closing time, the bid sheet will not be picked up from the table until the bidding has ended. Bidders must be present in person to continue bidding. In the event of a dispute, the Kama'aina Christmas Chairpersons will determine the prevailing bidder. At closing time, a silent auction attendant will circle the winning bid and collect the bid sheets. Please check the remaining bid sheet to find out if you are the highest bidder.

## **Payment**

The highest bidder on each item will be responsible for payment on the evening of Kama'aina Christmas by cash, credit card (Master Card, VISA, AMEX) or check. All sales are subject to a 4.712% Hawaii general excise tax. Cashiers will be ready to receive payment for your item(s) at **10:30 p.m.** All sales are final with no exchanges or refunds. Items purchased become the property of the successful bidder upon checkout. Payment is expected in full and all items must be removed from the premises on the evening of the auction unless otherwise noted. Please see the cashiers if size or weight prevents removal. Arrangements must be made the night of the auction. **If you prefer to pick up winning silent auction items on Sunday, December 13, 2009, pick up of silent auction items will be available from 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. at the Events Office, 2nd Floor, Banyan Courtyard. Entry through Ward Avenue Gate.**

In the event the winning bidder is not present when the auction closes, the winning bidder will be called during the following week with a request to arrange for payment and removal of auction item(s).

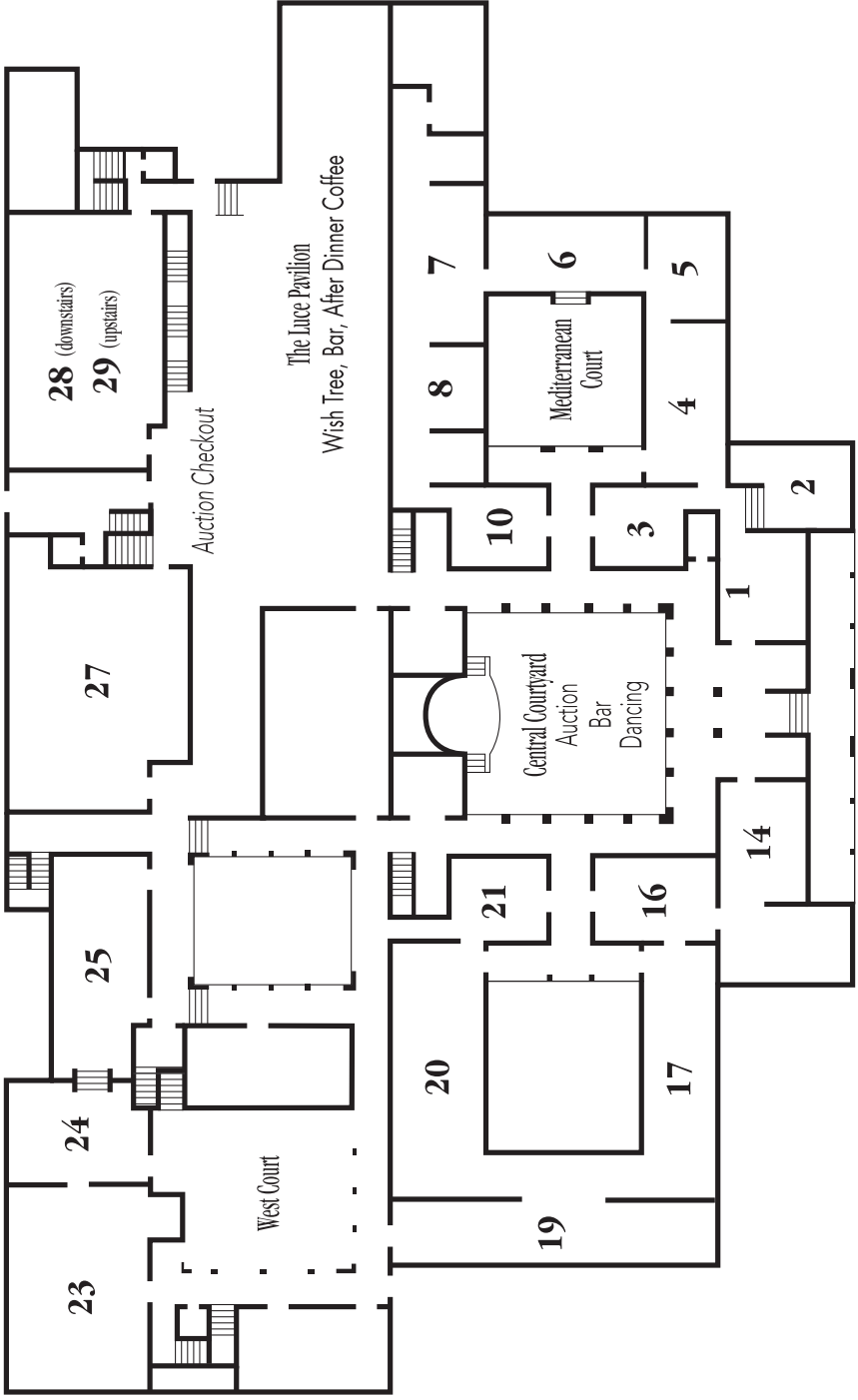
